


# The Holy Spirit



## I. Moment of Salvation

Act of God

 Rom 1:7, 11:29; Eph 1:8;

 1 Thes 2:12; 2 Thes 2:14;

**Spiritually dead condemned sinner & slave with eternal debt on eternal death row**



### Regeneration & Indwelling

Salvation/Eternal Life/ Reconnection

"en" = in & "oikeo" = dwell Rom 8:9; 1 Cor 3:16, 6:19

#### I. The People Indwelt:

1. Gift to All Believers: Jn 7:37-39, Acts 11:16-17; Rom 5:5; 1 Cor 2:12; 2 Cor 5:5
2. No HS = Unsaved: Rom 8:9; Jude 19; 1 Cor 2:14
3. Sinning Believers are Indwelt: 1 Cor 6:19



#### II. The Permanence of Indwelling: Rom 8:9; Jn 14:16

\*\*no examples Spirit leaving after Pentecost\*\*

**Spiritual death to Eternal Life**

Separated from God to Union with God by HS in you


**Regeneration:** New Birth, Spiritual Resurrection, New Creation  
 Titus 3:5

Others: 2 Cor 5:17; Jn 1:12-13; 3; 1 Pet 1:3,23; Rom 6:13; Col 2:12  
 1 Jn 2:29; 5:1,4; Eph 2:1-10; 4:24; Gal 6:15 Ezek 11:19-20

### Sealing

Ownership/Security

1. People Who Are Sealed = ALL: 2 Cor 1:22
2. Timing of Sealing = Salvation: 2 Cor 1:22; Eph 1:13; Acts 2:38
3. Agent of Sealing = HS: 2 Cor 1:22; Eph 4:30
4. Duration of Sealing = Until redemption: Eph 4:30; Rom 8:23
5. Ramifications of Sealing:
  - A. Security: earnest = guarantee or deposit
  - B. Purity

### Baptism

Spiritual Position/ID

- I. Characteristics of Spirit Baptism:** Join believers into body Christ
1. This Dispensation Only: Acts 1:5, 11:15-16
  2. All Believers: 1 Cor 12:13. (no exhortations); Eph 4:5 (unity)
  3. Occurs Once at Salvation: Aortist tense 1 Cor 12:13



- II. Consequences of Spirits Baptism: Rom 8:9; Jn 14:16**
1. Joins Us to Body Christ: unity, security, call to holiness, obedience for proper function in body vs renegade cell.
  2. Actualizes Our Co-Crucifixion with Christ: Gal 2:20; Rom 6:1-10; Col 2:12

**Redemption:**  
**Father:** Prescribes, Thought, Originating Cause  
**Son:** Provides, Bought, Mediatory Cause  
**Spirit:** Applies, Brought, Effecting Cause

### Filling of Holy Spirit

Spiritual Health/Power

Under Influence & Control of Holy Spirit by Submission/Yielding  
 \*\*Only Christians fully yielded to God\*\*

#### A. Characteristics of Filling

NT:4134 πλήρης πνεύματος & NT:4137 πληρώω πνεύματι


Luke 4:1 - Christ	Before the temptation (defeats Satan); before start ministry
Acts 6:3,5 - Stephen/1 <sup>st</sup> helpers	Service, witnessing, good reputation, spiritual
Acts 7:55 - Stephen	Saw JC. Obedient to death. Witnessing
Acts 11:24 - Barnabas	Encourager, full faith, People being saved
Acts 13:52 - Disciples	Filled with joy
Eph 5:18 - All Believers v19-21 = 4 evidences	Controlled by Spirit; Knowing will of Lord; Flowing through all your body under His influence. Keep drinking to be drunk **Greek present tense = needs continual renewal** **Keep being filled** **Passive = done to you**

1. Everyone can experience (Acts 13:52) but not all do (Acts 6:3)
  2. Paul commanded it since not all had it.
  3. Daily and dependent upon our freewill vs chosen by God in His sovereignty for 1<sup>st</sup> type
- \*\*State surrender & control to HS for all things, trusting in His power, will & guidance; pursuing holiness and agape love, dying to self; living with conscious presence of JC in you letting His word dominate our lives\*\***

#### B. Conditions for Spirit Filling:



1. **Quench Not The Spirit:** 1 Thes 5:19 – resisting or opposing His will. Not surrendered/yielded.
  - a. **Initial Act:** Rom 6:13, Mat 6:24, Rom 12:1 – our will to Gods will
  - b. **Continued Yielding:** Teachings of Word of God, Obedience to Spirits practical guidance, Acceptance by faith of Gods providential will & control all things & situations. Christ's example: Phil 2:5-11; Luke 22:42
2. **Grieve Not The Spirit:** Eph 4:30 – Presence of sin from unyielded Christians quenching Spirit = spiritual condition. Can appear like unsaved outwardly (i.e Lot). Sin = Barrier to fellowship. Connection broken. You move away like prodigal. 2 Cor 7:1 Sonship not lost but happy family relations disturbed.
  - a. **The Remedy = Confession 1 John 1:5-2:2.** Confession before restoration
    - 1. Self judgment, condemning & acknowledging own sin = restoration
    - 2. Sanctifying force to prevent further sin. i.e prodigal son
    - 3. Act of humility & dependence on God
3. **Walk by the Spirit:** Gal 5:16 – walk by power and presence of Holy Spirit
  - a. Overcome 3 Enemies: World, Satan, & Flesh by prayer, Word, worship.
